

## Peer Review Process

Authors send their manuscripts to the publisher. The publisher sends the anonymised manuscript and the checklist with the review criteria to two reviewers. There are four evaluation levels (score sheet review result): (1) accepted without change, (2) accepted after minor revision, (3) submitted for review after fundamental revision, (4) manuscript unsuitable.

Reviewers send their feedback including evaluation to the publisher after three weeks at the latest. The publisher gathers the feedback from all reviewers and sends it to the authors. If rated (2) or (3), authors review the manuscript. Reviewers will receive the revised version for re-examination. The review will be submitted not later than 3 weeks after receipt of the manuscript. If successful, the article will appear in one of the next editions. We follow the Vancouver guidelines for medical journals.
