



"ergoscience" is a scientific journal for Occupational Therapy.

It is published since 2006 and since January 2011 by Schulz-Kirchner Publishers. With 4 editions per year it aims to publish original papers of German speaking Occupational Therapists as well as reprints, research summaries, book reviews, notifications of university lectures, research groups, etc. ergoscience also announces and reports about congresses and other events.

The focus of ergoscience is among others to support the profession in Germany, Austria and Switzerland in obtaining a higher academic level. The publications of dissertations and other original papers reflect the occupational therapy topics in German speaking countries, and aim to enrich readers who are practicing, teaching or researching to exchange and discuss the contents.

All original papers go through a double blinded review process. An international team of eight publishers, experts and academics in occupational therapy, ensure a high quality of articles. The team is supported by a scientific board of 25 international Occupational Therapists.
